

## SECTION 11(8) OF THE COMPANIES ACT 1965

- (8) If the Registrar is of the opinion that a document lodged or registered with him –
- (a) contains matter contrary to law;
  - (b) contains matter that, in a material particular, is false or misleading in the context in which it is included;
  - (c) by reason of any omission or misdescription, has not been duly completed;
  - (d) does not comply with the requirements of this Act; or
  - (e) contains an error, alteration or erasure,
- the Registrar may request –
- (f) that the document be appropriately amended or completed and re-submitted;
  - (g) that a fresh document be submitted in its place; or
  - (h) where the document has not been duly completed, that a supplementary document in the prescribed form be lodged.
