## Subsector: Operations of contractors for disposal of scheduled wastes (clinical wastes - SW404)

SOPs	Details
Operating hours	24 hours
Collection/Transportation hours	8.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight
Worker capacity	100%
Handling of clinical wastes	• Ensure that clinical wastes are treated on the same day
	• All premises designated for disposal of scheduled wastes are required to activate their Emergency Response Plan and ensure that any damaged treatment equipment is repaired immediately
Use of full personal protective equipment ('PPE')	• Ensure that the handler of scheduled wastes wears a full PPE
Social distancing	• Ensure a social distancing of one metre when handling scheduled wastes
Use of hand sanitiser/ disinfection	• Compulsory to use hand sanitiser, wash hands with soap or clean oneself after handling scheduled wastes
Take and record body temperature of workers	• Take and record body temperature of workers daily before starting work
	<ul> <li>Workers with a body temperature exceeding 37.5°C or displaying any symptoms should be referred to the company's panel clinic or a nearby Health Clinic.</li> </ul>
Cleaning and sanitisation of premises	• Disinfect all storage areas, transport, lorries and tools/ equipment in accordance with the prescribed SOPs after handling wastes

SOPs	Details
Operating hours	8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m.
Collection/Transportation hours	8.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m.
Worker capacity	100%
Handling of industrial wastes	• All premises designated for disposal of scheduled wastes are required to activate their Emergency Response Plan and ensure that any damaged treatment equipment is repaired immediately
Use of full PPE	• Ensure that the handler of scheduled wastes wears a full PPE
Social distancing	• Ensure a social distancing of one metre when handling scheduled wastes
Use of hand sanitiser/ disinfection	<ul> <li>Compulsory to use hand sanitiser, wash hands with soap or clean oneself after handling scheduled wastes</li> </ul>
Take and record body temperature of workers	• Take and record body temperature of workers daily before starting work
	<ul> <li>Workers with a body temperature exceeding 37.5°C or displaying any symptoms should be referred to the company's panel clinic or a nearby Health Clinic.</li> </ul>
Cleaning and sanitisation of premises	• Disinfect all storage areas, transport, lorries and tools/ equipment at least two times a day after handling wastes
